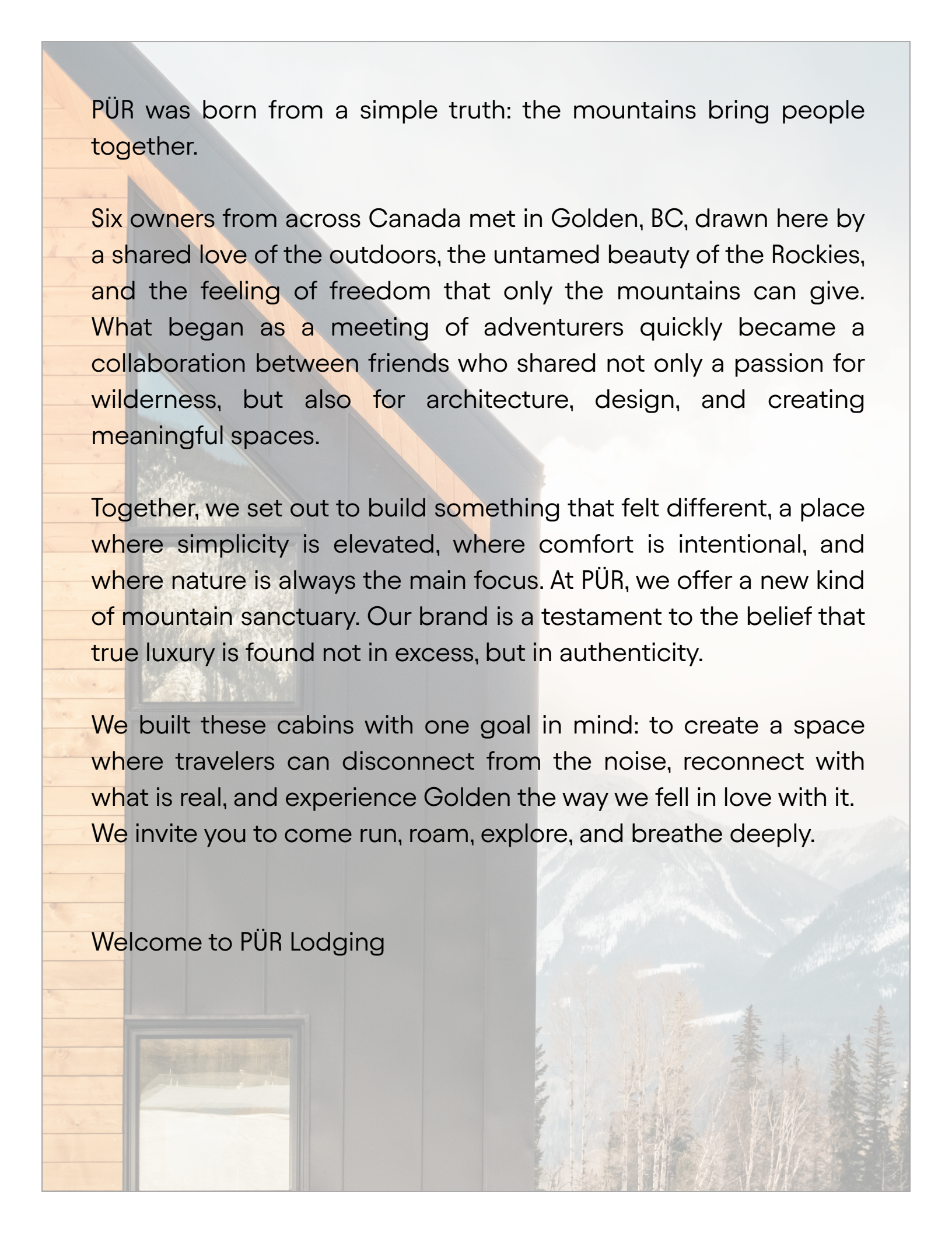


PÜR LODGING

- Maximum occupancy of 4 persons



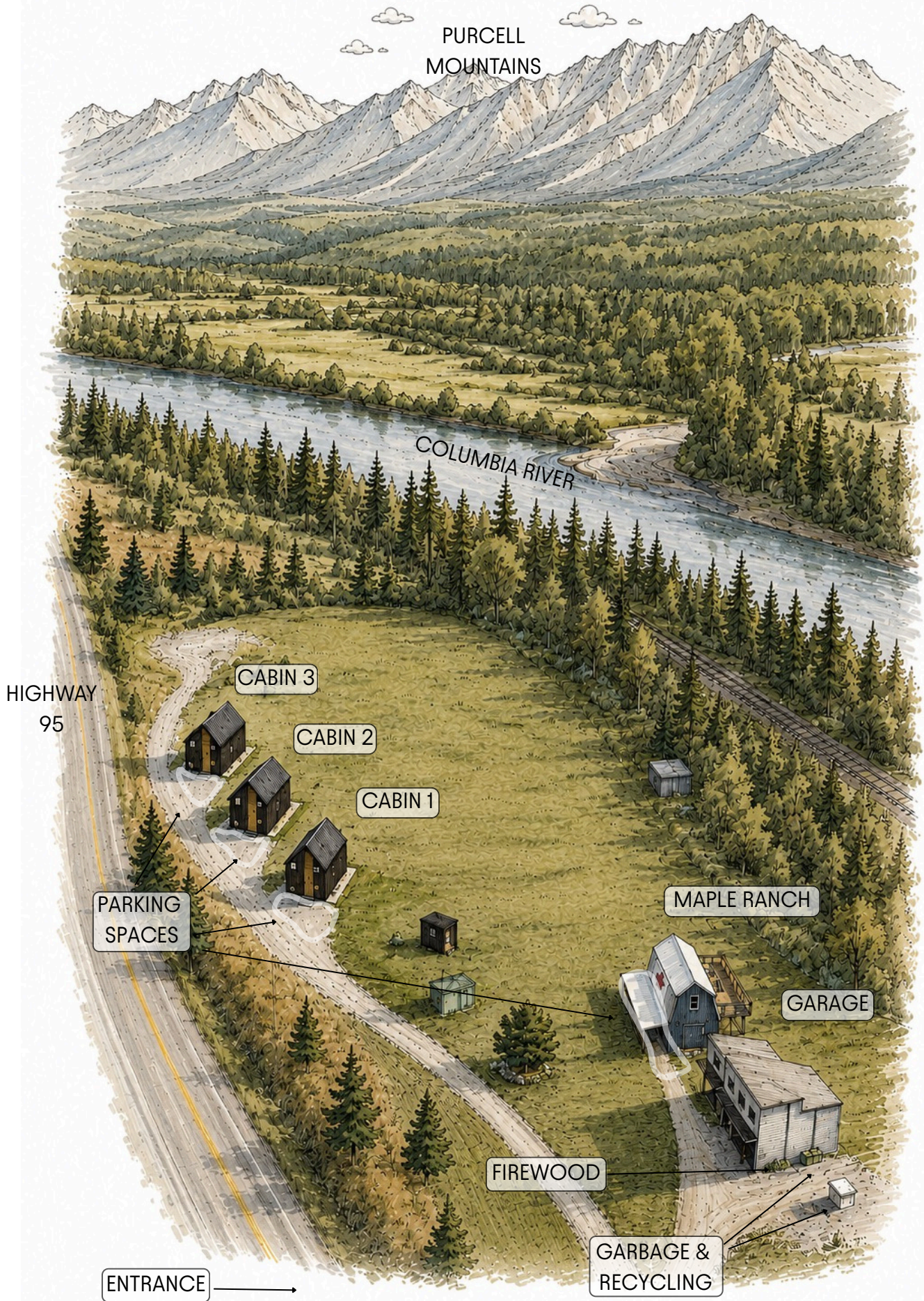
Please **use placemats and coasters** on all surfaces to help prevent damage.

No smoking inside the house. Please dispose of the cigaret butts in a safe manner and not on the driveway.

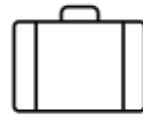


Parking: please refer to the map on page 6 for the parking area for your cabin.

CHECK-OUT PROCEDURE



Please follow the instructions below before checking out:

- Check-out time is at 11 AM sharp. *Some exception applies for events and full property rental. Please consult your booking confirmation.*
- Please ensure all dishes are cleaned.
- Don't strip the sheets off the bed, leave as is.
- Before leaving, please place all towels next to the laundry machine and start a load using coloured items only.
- All garbage and recycling must be brought to the designated area shown on page 6. Please ensure to respect signage.

POWER & WATER OUTAGE



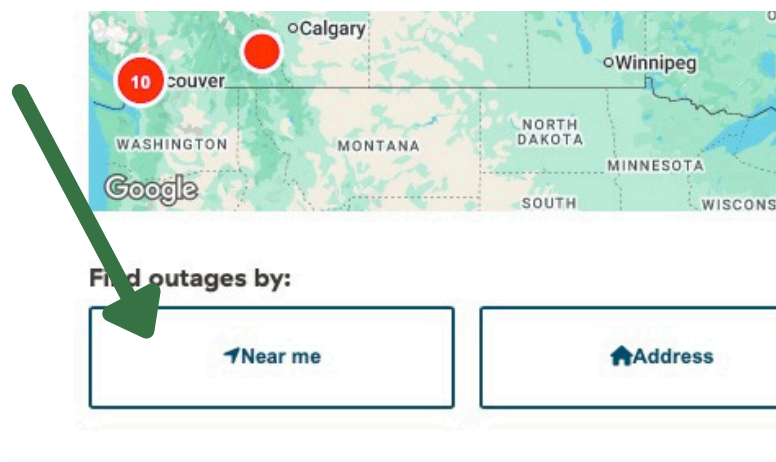
If the property has no power and no water, it looks like there is a general power outage. We unfortunately have no control over these situations as they are generally caused by the weather.

FIRE PIT

Firewood is provided at our self-serve station, and you'll find an axe there as well. Fire starters aren't provided, so feel free to bring your favorites along.

If there is a fire ban in place in our region, we will keep you informed through your booking platform.

For safety, please keep the fire pit in the designated location.

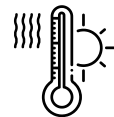
SOFA-BED

Linens for the sofa-bed are located inside the lounge section. Simply lift the section up.

To open the sofa-bed portion, simply pull on metal bar hidden behind the back cushions and everything will follow. There is no need to remove any cushion before this step.



ROOM TEMPERATURE



To create a comfortable temperature throughout your stay, electric baseboard heaters are available both upstairs and downstairs.

Each room is equipped with its own wall-mounted control, allowing you to adjust the temperature to your preference.

During the summer months, a portable air conditioner is available in the bedroom, positioned next to the bed to help ensure a restful night's sleep.

You can adjust the temperature using the remote control or directly on the unit.

CASTING- ROKU- TV



Streaming

- Use the Roku remote control to open the TV or click on the button with a house on it to bring you back to the right page.
- Enter your check-out date.
- You can now cast directly on the TV and all accounts will be signed out at the check-out date you entered. Please ensure you connect to your cabin number.

Cable

- Use the regular remote control to open the TV
- Click on "Guide" at any time to see the available channels and select the desired one.

BBQ GRILL

You will find a guide on how to use the BBQ on your cabin's table. Propane is provided. There is an extra tank next to the BBQ, please use the guide to see how to connect it.

Please wash the BBQ tools after use and burn off any excess food to ensure no animals are attracted.

COFFEE MACHINE

Your coffee machine is equipped with a reusable coffee capsule. Simply fill the capsule with your desired amount of ground coffee, close it and insert into the machine like a regular pod. Enjoy!



HOT TUB



1. The hot tubs are treated between each guest stay. We use chlorine as main sanitizer. Please leave the floating puck distributor in the hot tub.
2. The temperature is locked at 100° in the summer and at 104° in the winter.
3. Please take a quick shower before entering the hot tub. Soap or cream may create foam and damage the equipment. Also, remove grass or rocks under your feet.
4. Do not bring glass into the hot tub; plastic cups are provided.
5. To increase/decrease jet strength, manually turn the jet itself.
6. To turn on the hot tub and start jets : press the JET button twice.
7. To stop the jets : press the JET button once.
8. There is no need to shut down the hot tub when finished, it will automatically turn back to its regular cycles. Simply put the cover back on.
9. The water level shown on below pictures is the highest that this hot tub can be. The top jets will never be underwater.



Warnings

Children are at higher risk of overheating than adults. Keep children under the age of 7 out of the hot tubs. Their small bodies do not regulate temperature well and overheat too quickly.

Children over the age of 7 and pregnant women should use hot tubs at lower temperatures and for shorter durations.

Alcoholic beverages and some drugs can cause drowsiness. They can also lower the body's resistance to the effects of overheating. Do not consume these when using the hot tub.

HIKES



Emerald Lake- 1h from PÜR

A stunning emerald-coloured lake located in Yoho National Park. Many trails [easy to hard] start from there. Parking is free, but fill up quickly during peak season.

Wapta Falls- 45 minutes from PÜR

A great hike to a stunning glacier waterfall.

Difficulty: easy

Thompson Falls Trailhead- 45 minutes from PÜR

Discover the beauty of the Blaeberry River on this fun hike that finishes off with a powerful waterfall.

Difficulty: moderate

Mount 7- 25 minutes from PÜR

A hike up to the upper paraglider launch site to discover one of the most amazing view of Golden. Use Schacher Trail.

Note : a high-clearance vehicle is recommended for road access for some section of the road.

Difficulty: moderate

Gorman Lake- up to 1:30 to get to the highest possible by car

A hike on a well-built trail to a beautiful alpine lake.

Note : a high-clearance vehicle is recommended for road access.

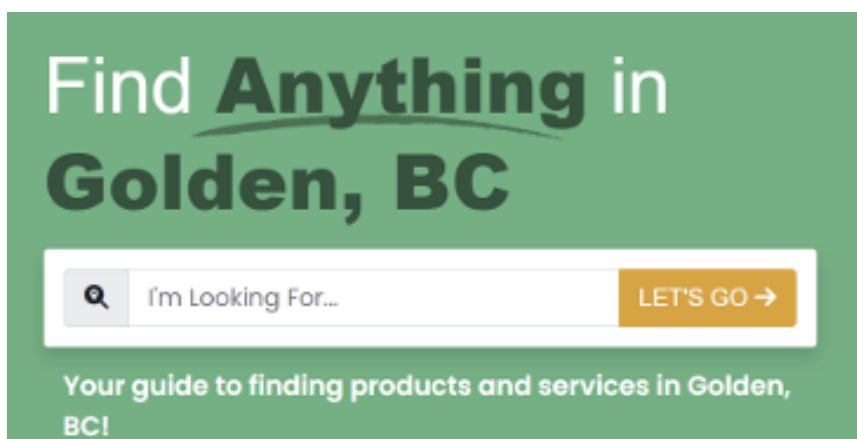
In case everything else is closed, there's always the 7-Eleven, open 24/7.
